Studying at the School of Business

- **Semester is divided into teaching periods:**
 - In autumn term (Sept-Dec): Period I and II
 - In spring term (Jan-May): Period III, IV and V
- **Every teaching period is followed by examination week**
 - Some courses have continuous assessment and they do not include a final exam.

 - Bachelor-level students can take master-level courses and vice versa (Exception: Finance)



5 facts about studying in Finland

1. **Exchange students are assigned a tutor, a fellow student who helps them with practicalities upon arrival**
2. **Meals at the student restaurants are subsidized by the government and cost only 3,2 euros**
3. **Students in capital region can get transportation card with just 35 euros a month**
4. **Exchange students coming in autumn term can volunteer in start-up event SLUSH**
5. **Student associations organize a lot of events throughout the semesters**

Student association of the Business Students - KY

- **KY is an association for business students at Aalto University**
- **Includes a subcommittee, KY-SUB, which is targeted at international students**
- **This year KY-SUB organizes for example:**
 - Welcome and Farewell events
 - Trip to Lapland every semester
 - Cruise
 - Cottage weekend
