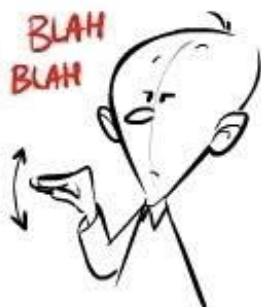

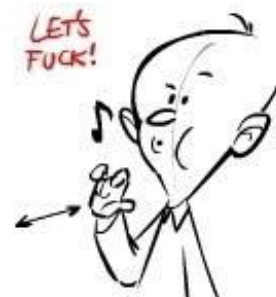

Our BSc and MSc degrees offer general and specific managerial competences based on a solid scientific and engineering background

3-year Bachelor of Science in Management Engineering (taught in **Italian**)

2-year MSc in Management Engineering (taught in **English**)

Every year **800** and **900** students enter the BSc programme and the MSc programme respectively; about 2.700 students overall

98% of placement within 1 year from graduation

What you should know...

- **About the Study Plan:**
- Students must fill out their **Study Plan online**, based on their **Learning Agreement** and following the instructions and deadlines provided by the [International Mobility Unit](#)
- The Study Plan registration will activate almost everything:
 - Exam registration
 - Access to online materials provided by our Faculty (BeeP portal)
 - Other online services
- The Study Plan can be changed every 6 months in the dedicated time-window (Sept/Oct – Feb/Mar)
- The Major can only be changed in September

What you should know...

About the Course Registration and Structure:

- By submitting your **Study Plan online**, you can register for classes
- Courses run by semester: Sept/Dec (exams in Jan/Feb); Feb/June (exams in June/July)
- Exchange students can enroll in **most Polimi classes** ([COURSE SELECTION](#))
- A full-time student enrolls for approx. **30 ECTS** credits
- Time-table is approx. 2 half-days per week
- **Attendance** is for the most part **not mandatory**, but it is better to inform the professor that you are there
- Most ME courses are **open** (no caps on courses) – PAY ATTENTION TO EXCEPTIONS
- Students must pay attention to class **location** – 7 Campuses!

What you should know...

– About Final Exams:

- Students **cannot** take exams for courses that are not included in their Study Plan
- It is up to you to choose when to take the exam (following the provided call calendar) but must be **taken during regular exam calls** (“Appello”)
- **Exam Calls** take place three times a year: June/July, September, January/February
- In order to take an exam, students **must sign up** for it in advance (online)
- You must provide an **ID Card** (with picture)
- **Exams** can be written, oral, or a mix. Some courses (e.g. labs) evaluate also assignments given throughout the semester
- Exams are evaluated in “30” points (**minimum passing grade 18**)
- A student can **refuse a grade** and try the exam again, following the provided exam calendar (pay attention to professor’s instructions)
- Some courses might have a mid-term exam (Nov - May)

What you should know...

- About your final thesis:

- Keep in mind that if you are studying at Polimi to pursue an international **double degree**, you will be required to end your program by discussing a final thesis, as all Polimi students
- All students must have a Polimi supervisor. Check with your home School's requirements for the type of thesis work (Polimi offers 2 options)

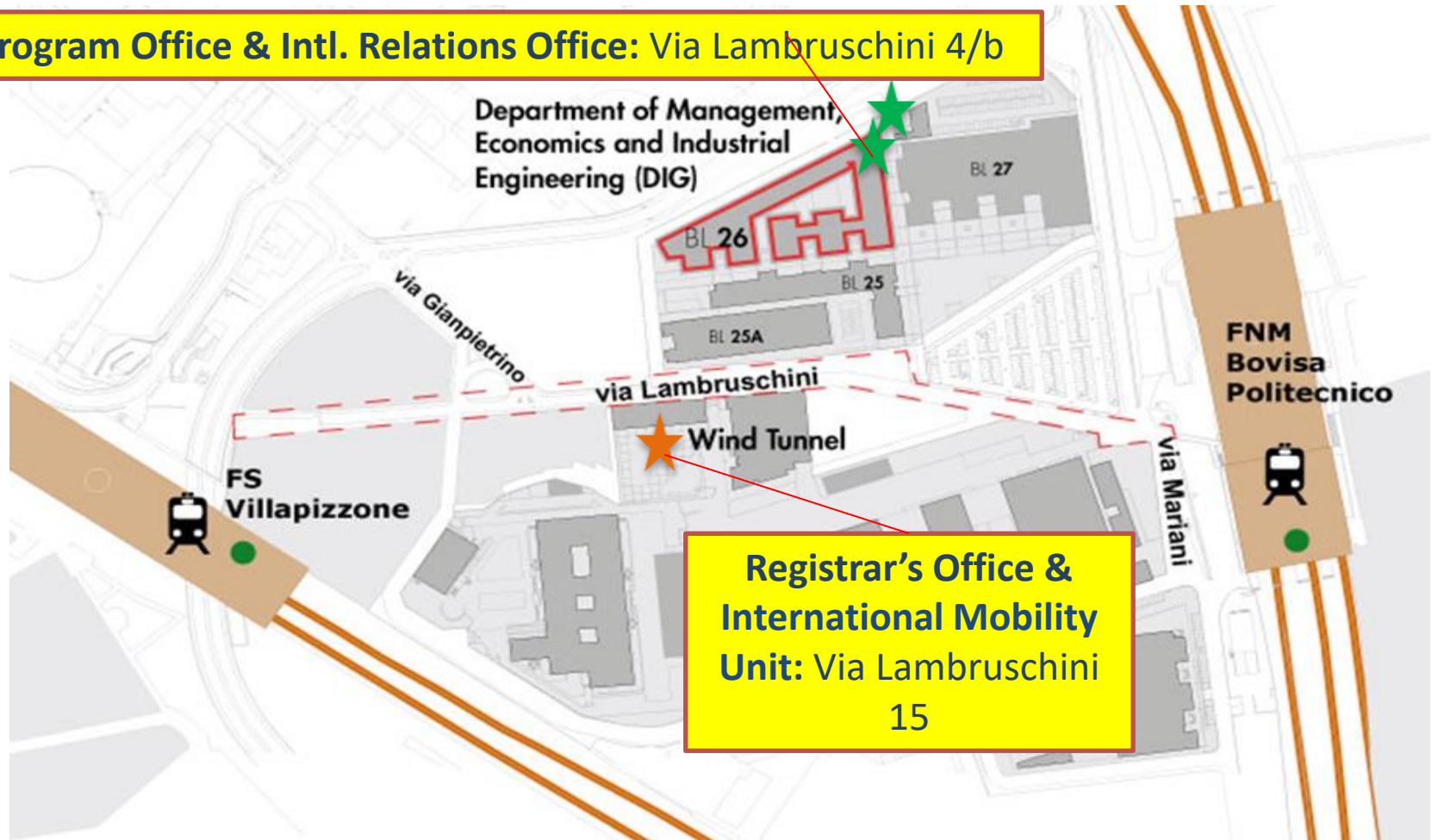
